You can use pluck to get a list of the column names for any given association. Product.pluck(:name) from the docs Returns an array of all the columns from a table. By default, it returns the id, created_at, updated_at columns. You can also include any associations in the query by adding the table name and an array of symbols indicating which associations should be returned. This will give you a set of columns of the form: ["id", "name", "A". If you want to get the products and menu together, you will need to join the data. You can do this via joins table, like this: join 'products_menus' on 'product_id =?', if it will return a select for the results, and you can send the results to a template for rendering.
