\* Apple's iPhoto and iMovie have replaced Photoshop for image editing in the Mac world. iPhoto and iMovie can do many of the same things Photoshop can, so you may as well learn how to use iPhoto or iMovie first. Apple also has a powerful video editing program called iMovie for making video, which is covered later in this chapter. I also recommend taking a look at graphics design and web design programs. You may think that Photoshop is the only game in town, but graphics design programs such as CorelDRAW and Illustrator offer functionality similar to Photoshop, though with more specialized functionality. Likewise, web design programs such as Dreamweaver do a fine job as an image editing program. I cover web design in Chapter 11, including how to use Dreamweaver. Photoshop Elements Photoshop Elements may seem similar to Photoshop in that it is a photo editing program, but it does have its unique features. For example, Photoshop Elements is a set of tools bundled together. Photoshop Elements has its own file format, which enables you to save images in an editable format for sharing. Plus, Photoshop Elements offers tools that allow you to edit video and create music. GIMP GIMP is an open source, cross-platform, free image editing program. Developed with an eye to usability, GIMP has a very responsive interface that responds to your actions on the screen. GIMP's file format is called GIF, and it supports some useful editing features that Photoshop does not. For example, you can add a white border to a photo by simply placing the photo in a white rectangular area on the Canvas (Image) panel, and you can select a square area of a photo that you want to leave unchanged and use it as a template for creating a new layer containing that image. You can even open a photo in GIMP and quickly apply a completely different filter in the same manner that you would apply a filter in Photoshop. I cover GIMP in depth in the next section. Photoshop Photoshop is the most popular software in the industry. It costs hundreds of dollars, but it is the best available image editing program for both the pro and the beginner. Though somewhat dated, Adobe Photoshop is packed with powerful tools for image editing

Apart from editing, Photoshop Elements can also create new images. It has six basic image-creation tools, which include the most commonly used Photoshop tools. In this Photoshop Elements tutorial, we will show you how to make a square logo using the Photoshop Elements Logo Editor. Step #1: Open the Photoshop Elements Logo Editor Open the Photoshop Elements Logo Editor Open the Photoshop Elements Logo Editor by going to File > New, then click on the "Photoshop Elements Logo" option. You will see an Editor screen similar to the one shown below. Editor Screenshot Step #2: Select an image Photoshop Elements Logo screen Select an image, by clicking on the Select Image button. Then, click on the "Invert" icon on the bottom left to invert the selection. Step #3: Resize and rotate image Click on the Background rectangle and drag it to the desired size. Then, click on the green Adjust icon to rotate the image to a desired degree. Step #4: Choose a background In this step, we will show you how to add a new background in the Photoshop Elements Logo Editor. Open the Select Color dialog box. Select a color from the left panel of the Photoshop Elements Logo Editor, using the Selection tool. Paint a color as per the desired background color. It is important to note that the color of the background is not easily visible as a solid color and instead, it is a subtle blend of blue and red tones. Step #5: Add a text layer Add text to the image. Open the Type dialog box. Enter the text and click on the Increase Text Size button. Step #6: Crop the image Click on the arrow icon located at the bottom left corner of the Photoshop Elements Logo Editor. This will open the selection tools screen. Select the Crop box from the list. This will crop the image to a shape similar to a square. Step #7: Place a new layer To create a new layer, click on the Add Layer icon in the top left corner. On the Layers panel, you will see a new layer called "Reserved". Reserved layer screen Step #8: Draw a rectangle Using the Rectangular Selection tool 05a79ccef
